- Early years – pre treaty
- Funding – 1992
- TLE Negotiations 1997 – 2019
- Purchase lodge – 1999
- **Strategic plan - 2003**
- Economic development activity – revenues grew to 1.2 m in 2010 and 6.5 million in 2018
- 67 businesses; partnerships, some wholly owned
- Involved in forestry, mining and real-estate
- Community population ~ 400
